

LABEL EVERYTHING

Yes, everything. This can be done with tape, a label maker, luggage tags, etc. PLEASE INCLUDE FIRST AND LAST NAME.

Trip Essentials

- What to bring to Drop Off: Besides all the gear, guardians should bring all camper medications in their original containers with the campers name on it. Please do NOT repackage the medication and keep it separate to hand to staff on arrival.
- Weather: Never underestimate the variability of weather! Daytime temperatures range from 30° – 90° F and higher, nights can be 50° less than a daytime high. Expect rain snow, and sunshine.



• In Case of Emergency: If something happens in the field, Avid4 Leadership will reach out with updates and action steps moving forward. If something happens at home, give the Avid4 office a call and we can connect you to your camper.

• Electronics: We have a no electronics policy to best support a "Disconnect to Connect" environment. There is limited cell service in the field and we also don't want anything to get broken!

• Who are the guides?: Avid4 Guides are medically trained outdoor professionals who come from a variety of backgrounds. Expedition guides have training in defensive driving and child care management.
